Call Waste Management at 329-8822.
- Do you pick up or clean out trash from resident homes?
No. We work with local organizations to recruit and coordinate volunteers to cleanup local roadways, neighborhoods and public lands.
- Where/When can I dump for free?
If you are a City of Reno resident you can dump during the Reno Clean & Green in April or October.
Lockwood Landfill has a free dump week the last week of April
All municipalities send out free dump vouchers to their residents usually with the Spring water bill (March/April)
- Is KTMB an affiliate of Waste Management?
No. Like local government entities we also work with Waste Management but we are a private nonprofit.
- Can I get community service through KTMB?
